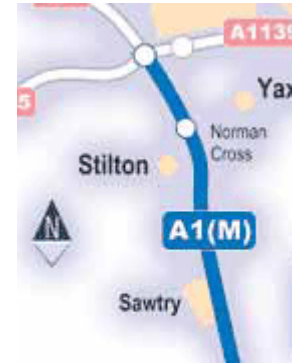
A1(M) Alconbury to Peterborough
